

Privileges and Benefits Retired UBC Faculty Members Without UBC Emeritus Status Revised November 2025

As a retired UBC faculty member without UBC Senate-awarded Emeritus status, you are entitled to certain benefits granted by UBC and the UBC Emeritus College. The following benefits apply whether or not you are a member of the UBC Emeritus College.

Benefit	Description	Helpful links
UBC Card	A new UBCcard may be obtained by applying online to the UBC Card Office. It will indicate <i>Retired Staff</i> .	https://ubccard.ubc.ca/obtaining -a-ubccard/emeritus-retired-staff
Library Privileges	UBC Library privileges for most services continue such as borrowing books and placing interlibrary loan requests. Access to library eResources continues if using a UBC computer; remote access is excluded.	https://services.library.ubc.ca/bo rrowing-services/get-library- access/faculty/
CWL	Your CWL remains active for 18 months after your retirement date to access pay and tax slips.	https://hr.ubc.ca/working- ubc/leaving-ubc
UBC Faculty Pension Plan	You have options with regard to the management of your pension as well as options for receiving income from the Faculty Pension Plan.	https://faculty.pensions.ubc.ca/li fe-events/retiring/
Health, Dental & Travel Insurance	 You may enroll in one or more of the following options: You are eligible to enroll in the UBC Sun Life Retirement and Survivor Benefits (RSB) Program if you were a member of the UBC Sun Life extended health or dental plan when employed. You can enroll in 1 or more of the 3 plans: Extended Health Care (EHC), Dental, and EFAP (Employee and Family Assistance Program). Enrollment must occur within 31 days of your actual date of retirement. You are eligible to enroll in the group plans secured by the UBC Emeritus College for retired faculty members: belairdirect (EHC/Journey Travel/Dental), RTOERO Entente (EHC/Travel/Dental/Hospitalization), and belairdirect (2 travel plans: Journey Travel and Travel Insurance Plan 3 (formerly MEDOC)). Life Insurance Conversion	You have the option of converting your UBC group plan of life insurance, accidental death and dismemberment plan to an individual policy with Sun Life Canada. UBC Post- Retirement Appoint- ments	Two types of appointments are available to retired UBC tenure stream faculty members, librarians, program directors and specific clinical faculty: Ohired into a regular faculty appointment (a new hire). UBC Tuition	BC residents who are Canadian citizens or permanent residents aged 65 years or over during the academic period in which they are registered are not assessed application, tuition, or student fees.
