## **4. Report from the Principal** (Anne Junker)

The College is now 5 years old. Membership stands at 1851 members (representing 20% of UBC academics), with 99 new emeriti acknowledged by Senate, and 6 members elected by Council. There are 5 new Order of Canada recipients. The office has 2 new staff: Queenie Law and Sarah Close Humayun.

#### Emeritus Activities 2022-23:

- 91 events:
  - o 58 meetings of 8 special interest groups; 3 groups involved 37 speakers
  - o 21 program events involved 37 speakers
    - 20 speakers in 6-part series with Green College on Disciplines Over Time\*
    - 12 speakers for Emeritus Cohort in PWIAS Climate program\*
       (\* showcasing interdisciplinarity and strong Indigenous voice)
- Co-sponsored with Faculty Relations, 2 Retirement workshops for 150 faculty (90 on wait list)
- Reimbursed 19 emeriti from 15 Departments \$27,855 for scholarly activities
- Met with interim President, Provost, Deans, Department Heads and Directors
